Liquid Incinerator

UMCDF Update

- Planned outage for the Liquid Incinerator (LIC) 1 is complete.
- Forced outage for the Deactivation Furnace System (DFS) continues with repairs to the Heated Discharge Conveyor (HDC).
- The DFS outage was not planned, but expected. Repairs normally are required after about a 12-month period of use.
- Although rocket processing has been progressing since Sept. 8, 2004, the DFS was used extensively during surrogate testing.
- Safely protecting all depot workers, the general public and the environment remain the depot's top priorities.
