

UMCDF Update

- Rocket processing operations resumed June 9 after the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality lifted the stop-processing order it issued May 18 following a fire during rocket processing in an Explosive Containment Room.
- Continued MC-1 GB bomb campaign preparations.
- UMCDF employees have worked over 1 million safe work hours without a lost workday.



Last week, a Depot chemical operations crew separated the rocket motor and warhead sections on nine M55 rockets sent to an Army lab at Picatinny Arsenal, N.J., for propellant sampling and analysis. The operation was part of the root cause analysis conducted as a result of a third rocket fire at UMCDF May 18.
