

- Project Total: **148,036** pounds

Tue, 8/30:	Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Wed, 8/31:	Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Thu, 9/01:	Eliminated 0 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Fri, 9/02:	Eliminated 102 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Sat, 9/03:	Eliminated 204 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Sun, 9/04:	Eliminated 350 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB
Mon, 9/05:	Eliminated 13 GB rockets and 0 pounds of GB

Friday, Sept. 2, rocket processing resumed following an 18-day scheduled maintenance outage in order to prepare the facility for upcoming agent trial burns. Agent trial burns are designed to test the environmental performance of the furnace systems. No agent was processed in the liquid incinerator due to maintenance activities.
