### Depot conducts biannual change of command

Lt. Col. Bob Stein assumed command of the Umatilla Chemical Depot from Lt. Col. Donna Rutten in a July 12 change of command ceremony. Stein is the 34th commander in the depot's 65-year history.

Prior to coming to the depot, he was assigned to the Republic of Korea as the U.S. Forces Korea/Combined Forces Combined Chemical Officer.

Stein, 41, was born in Pittsburgh, Pa. He graduated from Washington and Jefferson College in Washington, Pa., in 1988 and was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the U.S. Army Chemical Corps. He and his wife, Cindy, have a son, Sean, 14, and a daughter, Megan, 5.

#### UMCD/UMCDF Milestones

- **July 8, 2007:** Final GB 155mm projectile processed through the MPF — GB campaign complete.
- **July 3, 2007:** Final shipment of GB munitions from depot storage to disposal facility.
- **June 27, 2007:** Reached 1,000 nominal agent tons destroyed.
- **April 15, 2007:** Reached 25 percent of total agent tons destroyed.
- **Feb. 1, 2007:** Processed the first GB 155mm projectiles through the Metal Parts Furnace (MPF).
- **Jan. 25, 2007:** Began the GB 155mm projectile campaign with delivery of munitions from depot storage to the disposal facility.
- **Jan. 3, 2007:** Completed the GB 8-inch projectile campaign.
- **Nov. 6, 2006:** Processed the 100,000th munition stockpiled at Umatilla.
- **Sept. 28, 2006:** Began GB M426 8-inch projectile campaign.
- **Aug. 9, 2006:** Completed GB M55 rocket campaign.
